Debt Retirement

Anticipated Cost - \$800,000

- Phase III campaign (completed 2012) raised \$3.38M a primary element of Phase II was the construction of the Ministry Center
- Current parish debt of \$800,000

\$54,000 ANNUAL SAVINGS X 20 YEARS

= \$1,080,000 TOTAL SAVINGS

Debt Refinance

- Our current loan had a due date of May 2023. The current rate was 4.25%, with monthly principal and interest payments
- The goal of this Capital Campaign is to pay off this loan with pledge payments coming in over 3 years



Debt Refinance

- With rising interest rates, a new loan was secured with a fixed rate of 3.99%, interest only monthly payments
- There are no pre-payment penalties and principal will be repaid as soon as possible. The loan has a sevenyear maturity with a fixed rate
- This was recommended by the Finance Committee and approved by the Vestry in the May Vestry meeting



Solarize the Campus

Anticipated Cost - \$550,000

- Lead gift of \$400,000 to \$425,000
- Reduce Holy Comforter's carbon footprint by 50% by 2030 and achieve net zero emissions by 2045
- Reduce our electric expense up to 80% (\$500,000+ 25 yrs.)





Relocate & Enhance the Choir Room

Anticipated Cost - \$100,000

- Third floor relocation
- Double the space for our vital Music Ministry
- Improved acoustics, robing and music storage
- Dedicated Minister of Music office



Stewardship of the Campus

Anticipated Cost - \$200,000

- Refresh & increase funding for campus maintenance plan
- Fund various exterior and interior improvements, restorations, & maintenance
